When it’s most valuable

 - When delivery is struggling

- priorities are clear
- leadership is open
- there's a real need for change

It doesn't work when:

- the organisation wants "extra hands"
 - not leadership

A reality most people don't say

Fractional leadership isn't cheaper.

It's more efficient.

- speed
 - clarity
 - experience
